Food Safety Modernization Act (FSMA) Training

- **Food Safety Modernization Act Produce Safety Rule.** Meets the FDA Produce Safety Rule mandate for training for a supervisor or responsible party for each farm – Certificate Obtained. Cost: **\$20.00**
- **Food Safety Modernization Act Preventive Controls for Human Food Rule.** Meets the FDA Preventive Controls for Human Food Rule mandate for key personnel responsible for food safety becoming Preventive Controls Qualified – Certificate Obtained. Cost: **\$40.00**
- **Hybrid – Produce Safety Rule and Preventive Controls for Human Food Rule.** Meets the FDA training requirements for both Rules – two certificates obtained. Cost: **\$50.00**
