Invasive Plant Regulations?

Tier 1 plants listed below may NOT be sold after April 12, 2017.



- Ficaria verna (fig buttercup)
- Geranium lucidum (shining cranesbill)
- *Iris pseudacorus* (yellow flag iris)

On July 12, 2016, Tier 2 plants listed below can only be sold if this sign is posted near them.

- Euonymus alatus (burning bush)
- Ligustrum obtusifolium (blunt-leaved or border privet)
- Wisteria sinensis (Chinese wisteria)
- Wisteria floribunda (Japanese wisteria)
 - Wisteria x formosa (floribunda x sinensis hybrids)
