The Maryland Department of Agriculture, in conjunction with the University of Maryland Extension, has printed this list of the optional pre-exam training sessions and examinations for obtaining your Private Applicator Certificate. The list was developed to help you plan ahead to become certified. If you cannot make a session or exam in your county, you should contact a neighboring county about attending their session.

Extension conducts the training and schedules the exams. Exams are administered by a representative of the Maryland Department of Agriculture.

The list is broken down by geographical regions in Maryland. The training and exam dates, times and counties are listed for each of the regions. In some counties, due to the low number of individuals needing to take the examination, sessions have been combined. In the future, other areas of the state may take this approach.

These dates may be subject to change. You should contact your county extension office to obtain the study material, verify the date and time, and to register for a particular session.

In addition, some counties had not set their training or exam dates at this time so please contact your county extension office for more information.
