Congratulations on your decision to plant cover crops this fall. The Maryland Agricultural Water Quality Cost-Share (MACS) Program welcomes you as one of nearly 2,000 cover crop farmers who are working to protect local waterways, reduce soil erosion and increase the productivity of their crop fields.

It's time to begin planning your cover crop program. Please review the planting information and payment schedule so that you'll be ready to plant this fall.

To help create diversity and give farmers more planting options, cover crop mixes containing crimson clover, Austrian winter peas or hairy vetch may be mixed with the following grains: ryegrass, barley, rye, wheat, or triticale. The seeding rate is 60 percent cereal grains and 40 percent legumes or radish. The species with the earliest planting date determines the planting deadline. Mixes containing rye do not qualify for the \$10/acre rye incentive.

CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENT AND PAYMENT INFORMATION

All cover crops must be planted by November 5, 2016 and certified with the soil conservation district by November 14, 2016 to qualify for payment.

TRADITIONAL COVER CROP INCENTIVE PAYMENTS

Plant by October 1, 2016: Add a \$10-\$20/acre early planting bonus
Plant by October 15, 2016: Add a \$5-\$10/acre early planting bonus
Plant rye (no mixes): Add \$10/acre
MAXIMUM PAYMENT AMOUNT: \$75/ACRE

HARVESTED COVER CROP PAYMENT OPTIONS

Plant by November 5, 2016: \$25/acre

Plant rye as the cover crop: \$35/acre
