### Project Description:

Spay Neuter and vaccinate 600 cats in Somerset county

### Summary of Approach:

We use a few Newspaper ads and word of mouth about the grant many people borrowed Carriers and traps to bring us their pet cats. We conducted S&N clinics twice monthly transporting cats from Somerset county to Davidsonville Md and back to Somerset County

### Accomplishments:

We reached our 600 cat Goal in 9 months and helped many low income families with a big problem. We have received accolades from many people and from county officials about our partnership with the state AG department and our success

### Lessons Learned:

Needed to plan for more than 600 cats 900-1000 would have been more accurate.
