Project Description:

The project was on track to complete but due to our contractual Veterinarian retiring in October 2022 we have been unable to continue grant surgeries.

Summary of Approach:

We are actively offering this service to individuals/animals we believe would benefit from the service. We are advertising this service on our website and social media accounts. Our facility at this time is now open to walk-ins although we are requesting that people make appointments to remain as virtual as possible. There is now a greater opportunity to discuss the grant option with citizens in the building. Since resuming rabies clinics we actively hand out the grant applications. We have also made the application a fillable PDF form so that it can be easily emailed to a citizen and emailed back to us for approval. One last major source of advertising is that our facility is doing daily live Facebook videos and we are mentioning the grant services on these videos. As always if a citizen is wanting to surrender their animal and a barrier could be a spay/neuter surgery that would result in them keeping their animal, our receiving team is actively approving qualified individuals for

Accomplishments:

We were able to complete 188 surgeries out of 237 even though surgeries were halted in October of 2022 for the most part with \$370 in surgeries being completed in the 4th quarter of 2022.
