****ONLINE REGISTRATION NOW AVAILABLE FOR YOUR 2014-2016 FISCAL YEAR RENEWAL APPLICATION****

If you are a veterinary technician currently registered up to fiscal year 2013 (which ends June 30, 2013), you may renew your registration online for fiscal years 2014-2016 (the period covering July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2016). You will need the following information available before renewing online:

- 1.) Mailing, home, and primary practice addresses and contact numbers;
- 2.) Proof of having 24 hours of Continuing Education (CE) for the upcoming triennial period (July 1, 2013 – June 30, 2016);
- 3.) Technician number;
- 4.) The control number preprinted on your enclosed renewal application, which begins with "T2014-"; and
- 5.) A Visa, Mastercard, or American Express credit card for payment.

After your transaction is complete, you will have the option to print your registration certificate or have one mailed to you. If you choose to have it mailed, your registration certificate will be sent to your mailing address within approximately two weeks. If you do not receive your registration certificate in a timely manner, contact the Board's office at 410.841.5862.

If your online registration application is not completed by midnight, June 30, 2013, and you continue to practice veterinary technology, or hold yourself out as a registered veterinary technician, you may be disciplined by the Board.

****PROCEDURES FOR RENEWING YOUR VETERINARY TECHNICIAN REGISTRATION BY MAIL****

If you choose to renew your veterinary technician registration on paper instead of renewing it online, the Board must receive from you **ON OR BEFORE JUNE 15, 2013**, at the address specified below, the following items:

- 1.) Registration application, completed in full;
- 2.) Check or money order made payable to the Maryland Dept. of Agriculture in the amount of \$75.00; and
- 3.) Recordation on the application of having earned 24 hours of CE.

Provided the above-listed items are mailed to, and received at, the following address **ON OR BEFORE JUNE 15, 2013**, your registration to practice veterinary technology in Maryland will not lapse at midnight, Sunday, June 30, 2013:

Please be advised that if your application and check are received after June 15, 2013, you may be impacting your ability to lawfully practice veterinary technology for the 2014 fiscal year. It is recommended that you contact the Board's office, at 410.841.5862, to inquire as to the status of your registration.

Please ensure that your application is complete when submitted, or it will be returned to you for completion. Your veterinary technician registration will not be processed until your application is completed in full.

In accordance with Family Law Article, §10-119.3, Ann. Code of MD, licensing authorities in Maryland are required to have in their records a Social Security Number for an individual who is issued a license, certificate, registration, or permit. Please ensure that this number is included on your registration application or the application will not be processed.
