3. I agree to purchase poultry only from certified NPIP members or to isolate new poultry and conduct NPIP testing prior to introducing them into my flock.
4. I also understand that, as a participant, I may exhibit my birds in Maryland and sell live poultry and hatching without further testing requirements within Maryland. I may also ship interstate without further testing, depending on the requirements of the state of destination.
5. I understand that the cost of participation in the NPIP program is \$25 annually for flocks and \$50 annually for commercial hatcheries. There may be additional fees associated with required testing.
