MARYLAND HORSE MONTH OCTOBER 2022

The Maryland Horse Industry has more than 101,000 horses, more horses per square mile than any other state in the United WHEREAS, States; and

The equestrian industry has an annual economic impact of \$2.1 billion in Maryland and helps to preserve more than 700,000 WHEREAS, acres of land; and

There are 35 different equestrian disciplines in Maryland that represent more than 40 breeds of horses and ponies; and WHEREAS,

The diversity of the Maryland Horse Industry is represented by farriers, small business owners, farmers, feed dealers, tack WHEREAS, shops, veterinarians, trainers, exercise riders, fox chasing clubs, steeplechase participants, therapeutic riding centers, breeders, horse riding clubs and teams, owners, rodeo participants, 4-H participants, racing participants, and many others;

The State of Maryland is host to several internationally renowned equestrian competitions and races, including the Preakness WHEREAS, - one of the three jewels in the Triple Crown - the Maryland Million, which showcases some of Maryland's best stallions and Maryland-bred Thoroughbreds, and the Maryland Sire Stakes, which honors the tradition of standardbred racing; and

WHEREAS, The State of Maryland has been selected to host an international 5 Star equestrian three-day event at the Fair Hill Natural Resources Management Area Special Event Zone - making it one of only two in the United States and one of seven in the entire world at this competition level; and Maryland is now home to the prestigious Washington International Horse Show at the Prince George's Equestrian Center and the new Maryland Horse Library and Education Center on Main Street Reisterstown.
