From the Governor of the State of Maryland

## MARYLAND AGRICULTURE TRADE DAY MARCH 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025

- WHEREAS, Maryland's total agriculture exports of \$935 million support more than 73,000 jobs in the food and agriculture and related supply chain sectors; and
- WHEREAS, Maryland's thriving agriculture sector provides jobs across the state not only for farmers and ranchers, but also for scientists, processors, shippers, trucking and retailers; and
- WHEREAS, Maryland is a leader in agricultural production and exports in the United States, providing a vast array of products that are critical both domestically and internationally; and
- WHEREAS, Maryland's leading agriculture exports include but are not limited to poultry, soybeans, grain, dairy products and processed vegetables; and
- WHEREAS, It is imperative to raise awareness among consumers, businesses, and policymakers about the challenges and opportunities facing agricultural trade.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim MARCH 19<sup>th</sup>, 2025 as MARYLAND AGRICULTURE TRADE DAY in Maryland and call upon the people of our state to join in this observance.
