

APPLICATION FOR PROFESSIONAL FERTILIZER APPLICATOR (PFA) CERTIFICATION EXAM WINTER 2021-2022

The Fertilizer Use Act of 2011 requires individuals who, as part of their job, apply fertilizer to turf on non-agricultural land, be certified or work under the direct supervision of someone who is certified, and that businesses that employ certified fertilizer applicators must be licensed. The requirements for certification, licensing and other program criteria are explained in detail at http://mda.maryland.gov/resource conservation/Documents/Fertilizer Law.pdf

Certification Exam Application Requirements:

To apply for the certification exam, an applicant shall file the following with the Department of Agriculture before any announced examination:

- a) A Professional Fertilizer Applicator (PFA) certification application on a form provided by the Department; the certification fee is \$100.
- b) Provide a Fertilizer Application Business License (MDA-F) number, or a completed business license application on the form provided by the Department. The fee for a Business License is \$50.
- c) Fees are payable to the *Maryland Department of Agriculture* in the form of check or money order. NOTE: Employees of government agencies and government agencies are not charged a certification or licensing fee.

Applications must be **completely** filled out and accompanied by the fee. Incomplete applications will be put on hold. A business FEIN or individual SSN are required. Certification and business licenses are valid for up to one year and expire June 30 of each year.

Testing Information

- A government-issued photo ID is required to enter the building and to sit for the exam.
- This is not an open-book exam. Before the review session or the exam, study the *Maryland Professional Lawn Care Manual*. It is available for viewing or download from the link on <u>mda.maryland.gov/fertilizer</u>. The test consists of 50 multiple choice questions.
- Please Bring a Calculator (that is not on your cell phone) and two #2 pencils for the exam
- No cell phones are allowed in the testing room, but regular calculators are allowed.
- A score of 70% or better is required to pass. You may try to pass the exam a total of three times, or within 3 months, whichever comes first, from the date of your first attempt to pass the exam. After this point you must register as a Trained Employee (TE) with your company or agency in order to apply fertilizer to turfgrass. In addition, your company or agency is prohibited from applying fertilizer to turfgrass without having a PFA on staff.

A review session offered before the exam. Attendance at the review session is encouraged but not mandatory.

FERTILIZER APPLICATOR BUSINESS LICENSE

- 1. Any person or company who wants to apply nutrients to turfgrass for hire or as a part of his job must be a) licensed by the Maryland Department of Agriculture and b) have at least one Maryland Certified Professional Fertilizer Applicator on staff.
- 2. Employees of Licensed companies or agencies who fertilize turfgrass must be registered with the State and work under the direct supervision of someone who is a Maryland Certified Professional Fertilizer Applicator.
- Persons or companies wishing to obtain a License to fertilize turfgrass must submit an application with the following fee:
 Privately held company or sole proprietorship \$50.00
 Government agency No licensing fee
- 4. A Fertilizer Applicator Business License is valid for up to one year and expires on June 30 of each year.
- 5. Licensed persons or companies agree to comply with regulations set forth in COMAR 15.20.10.
- The following regulatory requirements apply:
 - a. Each business location that employs a person to fertilize turfgrass must have a Fertilizer Applicator Business License.
 - b. Each business location that employs a person to fertilize turfgrass must have a Certified Professional Fertilizer Applicator on staff.
 - c. Only Maryland Certified Professional Fertilizer Applicators or registered Trained Employees working under the direct supervision of a Professional Fertilizer Applicator may apply fertilizer to turfgrass.
 - d. Maryland Certified Professional Fertilizer Applicators shall maintain records of fertilizer applications in accordance with the requirements of COMAR 15.20.10.13.
 - e. Fertilizer Applicator Business License holders shall keep records for a minimum of three years and make them available to the Department upon request.
 - f. Fertilizer Applicator Business License holders must file with the Department by March 1 of each year an Annual Activity Report covering the previous year (January through December) that summarizes all turfgrass fertilization on a form specified by the Department.
 - g. <u>The Fertilizer Applicator Business License number (MDA-F) shall be displayed on company vehicles used for fertilizing work.</u>
 The lettering shall be 2 inches high and placed on both sides of the vehicle.
