1. Calculate your three-year average of gross PRODUCE sales for the years 2023-2025. Produce includes fruits, vegetables, mushrooms, peanuts, tree nuts, herbs, microgreens and sprouts irrespective of seed source, grown by and/or purchased and sold by you/your operation.

If your three-year average is greater than \$34,324 you are not eligible for this exemption. If your three-year average is less than \$34,324 you are eligible for this exemption.

The Produce Safety Rule does not consider a farm or farm mixed-type facility with an average annual monetary value of produce sold during the previous three-years, with a value less than \$34,324 as a covered farm.
