WORKER FOOD SAFETY TRAINING FOR FSMA PRODUCE SAFETY RULE COMPLIANCE – SPANISH VERSION

- The Produce Safety Rule requires all workers to be trained for their duties that are related to food safety in their language. The training must include relevant sources of food borne pathogens, routes of contamination, preventive measures and corrective measures and documentation that workers have received this training must be maintained by farms growing produce that must comply with the Produce Safety Rule. This three hour training provides the basic food safety training for workers necessary to comply with the Produce Safety Rule.
- Two 3 hour identical sessions will be held on May 1, 2019 – one from 9:00 a.m. to Noon and one from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Workers only need to attend one of these sessions.
- Who should attend?
Spanish speaking workers that have duties related to the growing, harvesting, packing, and holding of produce (any produce that is not considered to be rarely consumed raw) that must comply with the FSMA Produce Safety Rule.
