The Maryland Department of Agriculture, is offering growers an opportunity to dispose of unusable pesticides at no cost. If you would like to take part in the program, please complete this registration form. Once the Department receives your registration, a member of the Pesticide Regulation Staff will contact you to make arrangements to inspect and verify the types and amounts of pesticides that you have registered. If you have a pesticide that is not in its original container and/or one that is unknown, a sample will be collected at the time of the inspection and analyzed by the Department or the contractor at a later date. If a pesticide container is in poor condition and could possibly leak if moved, only record the information that can be obtained without moving the container. Further information on this program can be obtained from the MDA Pesticide Information Sheet No. 13, Pesticide Disposal Program.

An accurate inventory of pesticides, for disposal, must be developed in order to the Department to request and receive bids for the disposal program. Please make sure that you provide the following information:

PLEASE PRINT THIS INFORMATION

- Name, address (street/road and city/ town) and county.
- Telephone number
- Name and daytime telephone number of a contact person. This is an individual that will have information about the pesticides intended for disposal.
- Address (street/road and city/town) and county identifying the location of stored unusable pesticides.
- Directions and/or a map to the pesticide storage site.
- If more space is required to list your pesticides, attach additional sheets, as needed, to the Unusable Pesticide Registration Form.

This program is open to all agricultural operations (Farm, Forest, Nursery, Greenhouse, etc.) throughout Maryland. Commercial businesses may be allowed to participate at MDA's contract cost.

While MDA anticipates being able to conduct collections throughout Maryland, registration does not guarantee pick-up. MDA will review registrations and determine which areas of the State will be serviced. Operations not chosen for the current program, will be notified and placed on a waiting list.
