Record Keeping Requirements for Exported Manure

If your animal raising or boarding operation is subject to nutrient management reporting in the State of Maryland, please be aware that new reporting requirements went into effect on October 1, 2019 as a result of Senate Bill 546.

The Annual Implementation Report (AIR) that you submit to the Maryland Department of Agriculture by March 1st of each year will have an expanded manure transport section. It will require you to list all the recipients of your exported manure, as well as the amount that they received.

The following table is an example of how you can keep track of takers of your manure. Make it a point to record this information each time manure is exported from your farm.
