Congratulations on your decision to plant cover crops this fall to protect local waterways, reduce soil erosion, and improve soil health.

It's time to begin planning your cover crop program. Please review the planting information and payment schedule so that you'll be ready to plant.

Two-species cover crop mixes may be planted at a rate of 50% cereal grains (including oats) and 50% radish, legumes, or canola/rape. Three-species mixes (50/25/25) must contain a minimum of 50% eligible small grains. The species with the earliest planting date determines the planting deadline. Drones are an aerial seeding option and mixes containing rye or triticale or a multi-species cover crop qualify for a \$20/acre incentive payment.

Certification Requirement and Payment Information

- Cover crops must be planted by November 5, 2024 and certified with the local soil conservation district by November 12, 2024 to qualify for full payment.
- Late-planted cover crops must be certified by November 22, 2024. All follow-up documentation must be submitted to the local soil conservation district by December 2, 2024 to be eligible for payment. NOTE: Termination of late planted cover crops must take place after May 1.
