

Project Synopsis:

We provided free neuter services to low income Calvert County residents.



Project Description:

Calvert County residents with an annual household income of \$50,000 or less were provided with free canine neuters at three local Veterinary Hospitals,

Summary of Approach:

Proof of residency and annual household income were required. Once established the pet owner selected a Veterinarian and made the appointment. The Vet billed us for the surgeries.

Accomplishments:

Thirty nine males dogs living in low income homes were neutered at no charge to the owner. Unneutered male dogs are often turned in to shelters for behavior problems.

Lessons Learned:

People try to get around the income requirements by putting the pet in their children's names, saying they have no income and therefore no tax forms, etc..
