To spay 240 cats from our focus areas around Prince Georges County.

We have an amazing team of volunteers that often live in the communities and know them well. They are often of the same culture and background as those feeding the cats so they are very effective at locating the cats and getting the feeders to understand the importance of trap, neuter, return.

Accomplishments:

We were successfully able to spay 240 cats over the last 10 months from our focus areas. We have even expanded our volunteer base and added more volunteer management positions to help make the entire process more effective and efficient.
