Project Synopsis:

BARCS was able to successfully spay/neuter and vaccinate against rabies 1,800 outdoor community cats.

Project Description:

Funding for this project was used to spay and neuter 1,800 outdoor community cats through the BARCS TNR program.

Summary of Approach:

Funding was utilized to TNR (trap, neuter, release) outdoor community cats. Baltimore City residents were encouraged to reach out to the BARCS Community Cat Program team with requests for assistance in altering outdoor cats. We then scheduled surgery appointments and, once healed, released cats back to their community.

Accomplishments:

We successfully altered 1,800 cats!
