

**Project Information****Project Synopsis**

Forgotten Cats trapped, sterilized, recuperated, and released 750 free roaming cats residing within the Worcester County cities of West Ocean City, Berlin, Ocean Pines, Pocomoke City, Bishopville, Whaleyville, Snow Hill, Girdletree, and Stockton. For the past four years, due to the funding we were awarded through the Maryland Department of Agriculture Spay and Neuter Grants Program, we have had a consistent TNVR presence in Worcester County. This grant scope was expanded to include cats from Somerset Maryland.

#### Summary of Approach

Our approach is to work with colony caretakers to trap and sterilize entire colonies to ensure zero colony growth.

#### Accomplishments

FC successfully completed the grant by performing TNVR on 750 cats from West Ocean City, Berlin, Ocean Pines, Pocomoke City, Bishopville, Whaleyville, Snow Hill, Girdletree, and Stockton and Somerset County. In addition to providing TNVR of 750 cats FC also provided additional surgery or medical care to the cats in need. FC did not request additional money for these services.

#### Lessons Learned

As we continue to sterilize cats in the designated areas within Worcester County, colony caretakers have accepted that TNVR is the only way to control the free roaming cat population. As a result, colony caretakers are more inclined to call when there are only a few cats as opposed to hiding and seek out assistance when they are totally overwhelmed.
