### Project Description

Spay/Neuter services were provided for low-income family pets in Cambridge, Dorchester County.

### Summary of Approach

Animals were brought to Baywater Animal Rescue on the morning of their surgeries, then transported to and from veterinarian offices for spay or neuter. They were then returned to their owners on the evening of their surgery.

### Accomplishments

Seventy animals were treated. The expenses incurred by Baywater Animal Rescue exceeded the grant funding, however the organization was able to pay all expenses because it had some matching funds.

### Lessons Learned

A very successful and efficient process was developed for these procedures and we will be able to execute more efficiently in the future.
