Residents living in Dept. of Ag. designated zip codes may contact BARCS for spay/neuter services for their animals. BARCS schedules and performs the surgery and offers aftercare information to pet owners.

Accomplishments:

BARCS exceeded our stated goal of 810 animals by altering 849 animals! This grant was also completed on time and within budget.
