Project Synopsis:

This purpose of the program was to reduce the amount of euthanasia's by offering Prince George's County residents free spay and neuter services.

Project Description:

The requested grant amount was for 40K, to service a total of 600 cats. in Captial Heights, Maryland. The county grant amount was \$18k, and we were able to extend the grant to other needed areas in the county and service a total of 259 animals.

Summary of Approach:

The Animal Services Facility worked closely with both feral cats TNR groups and our Spay Spot Clinic to spread the word about the free clinics and services to reach as many people as possible. The free clinics was the most successful means of getting the services to the community.

Accomplishments:

Requesting an extension of the grants to service more zip codes, enabled the county to reach more communities, engage the community in services offered by the facility, and bring awareness to the community about the importance of spay and neuter and animal welfare needs.

Lessons Learned:

This year when we applied for the grant, we were sure to extend the services throughout the county to ensure expedite high traffic season of animal welfare needs.
