Renewal Extension Request

- **Dr. Hillary Merry** Requesting an extension on getting CEs for renewal due to a medical condition.
 - Due to the uncertainty of when Dr. Merry will be able to get the Continuing Education completed the Board has requested that they reach out to us when they know more and the Board will waive a late fee if applicable for late registration. Past 1 year they can apply for reinstatement.

Inquiry From Dr. Amy Zhang at Green Valley Animal Hospital regarding the treatment of domesticated wild animals.

- Owner seeking routine medical care for a F2 Savannah Cat (2nd generation hybrid between African Serval and Domestic Cat).
 - Hospital research says Maryland (other than Baltimore) allows all generations of Savannah Cats under 30lbs. (not verified)
 - Frederick County Animal Control stated that they would consider it a domestic cat and have the same vaccination and licensing requirements. ACO is checking with the Health Department for any guidelines if there is an injury from the cat.
 - You have the ability to choose patients; there are no regulations specifying species.

Inquiry from Suzy Gill-Boucher - Practice Manager at Mount Carmel Animal Hospital regarding administering client provided vaccinations.

- Can a private citizen purchase rabies vaccines?
- Can a veterinary practitioner administer a rabies vaccine that they did not purchase and cannot verify the authenticity, shipping, handling, and storage before it reaches us?
- Does this apply to other vaccines such as distemper, lepto, etc?
 - No the Board would not recommend doing this as they are unknown storage potentially causing decreased efficacy.

Maryland Agricultural and Resource-Based Industry Development Corporation (MARBIDCO)

- The Board reviewed information provided by MARBIDCO's Executive Director Steve McHenry. The information is for a new Loan program to promote agriculture veterinarian practice startups for specialized equipment.
