## **Minutes of the Joint Open Meeting**

Dr. Callahan called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m.

**Approval of the Minutes**. In a motion by Dr. Reed, seconded by Dr. Radue, the minutes of the January 28, 2021 Board Meeting, as edited by Dr. Joung, were unanimously approved.

<u>Veterinary License Applications Approvals</u>. In a motion by Dr. Callahan, seconded by Dr. Joung, the veterinary license applications were unanimously approved for Drs. Lauren Mundy, Jennifer Bottaro, Heather Zimmerman, Valliyatte, and Muller.

<u>Sanitation Reports</u>. Inspectors Morgan and James reported on the inspections they have completed since the February meeting. In a motion by Dr. Radue, seconded by Dr. Reed, the Board voted unanimously to accept the Sanitation reports.

<u>**CE Approval Requests</u>**. In a motion by Dr. Joung, seconded by Dr Radue, the Board voted to approve the follow up from request #385; as well as requests #390, #391-and #392-402 for the American Association of Animal Laboratory Science.</u>

In a motion by Dr. Callahan, seconded by Dr. Calvert, the Board voted unanimously to approve the Dripvet 411-Opioid course to meet the CDS CE requirement.

**<u>COMAR Chapter One Proposed Revisions</u>**. A working draft of proposed changes to COMAR 15.14.01 was approved to be shared with the MVMA Board during their March 10, 2021 meeting for preliminary input.
