- In a motion by Dr. Reed, and seconded by Dr. Schmechel, the team voted to make the following determination regarding the request from Dr. Donati and Dr. Valenzano.
 - o In regards to the foreign heart surgeon specialist, the Board generally supports the request to train staff to do the procedure, however, consulting is generally a third party giving advice that would not include performing surgery. They could be there in a third party role to give feedback, but not directly perform surgery. Couldn't actually be involved in the surgery. Statute doesn't allow for this and would need to be licensed in Maryland.
