In a motion by Ms. Chaput, and seconded by Dr. Sobota, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the meeting to move into an administrative closed session to perform administrative functions outside the scope of the Open Meetings Act, in accordance with § 3-103(a)(1)(i) of the General Provisions Article. The administrative functions to be performed include discussion of the specific matters identified on the Board Agenda. In the alternative, I move to close the meeting pursuant to the following Section 3-305(b):

(2) to protect the privacy or reputation of an individual with respect to a matter that is not related to public business;

- (7) To obtain advice of counsel;
- (8) To consult with staff, consultants, or other individuals about pending or potential litigation;
- (12) To conduct or discuss an investigative proceeding on actual or possible criminal conduct;" and
- (13) To comply with a specific constitutional, statutory, or judicially imposed requirement that prevents public disclosures about a particular proceeding or matter.

Following a motion by Ms. Chaput that was seconded by Dr. Sobota, the members voted unanimously to close the meeting for the reasons stated, and to adjourn into administrative closed session.

FOR THE PUBIC MINUTES: During closed session, pursuant to General Provisions Article § 3-305(b)(2), the members discussed two requests for conditional registration for licenses who had not satisfied the annual CE requirements of COMAR 15.15.10.04 due to personal medical issues. After considering the requests, the Board voted unanimously to register the licenses of the two veterinarians. The Board also performed administrative functions not subject to the Open Meetings Act by reviewing and discussing pending disciplinary actions.
