**SHORT TITLE:** MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL COMMISSION - HEMP INDUSTRY MEMBER

#### EXPLANATION:

House Bill 100 would increase the membership of the Maryland Agriculture Commission from 30 to 31 members and require the additional member be appointed from the hemp industry.

#### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Maryland Agriculture Commission is board appointed by the Governor, which serves as an advisory body to the secretary and deputy secretary of the Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA).

The commission pursues the following priorities and activities:

- Encouraging the agricultural community to be more pro-active on issues affecting agriculture and rural life;
- Evaluating farm/agriculture industry labor and regulations;
- Increasing public awareness of food safety; and
- Supporting the department's efforts to promote agriculture.

MDA recognizes that hemp is an emerging industry in Maryland, and we have been working with the governor's office to actively fulfill the intent of the legislation to place a representative on the Maryland Agriculture Commission.
