### Legislative Comment

**Date:** January 14, 2021

**BILL NUMBER:** Senate Bill 344

**SHORT TITLE:** Agriculture - Cost-Sharing Program - State Cost-Sharing Funds

**MDA POSITION:** Support

#### **EXPLANATION:**

This legislation will allow the Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA) to provide up to 100% State funding assistance (currently limited to 87.5%) for the implementation of certain high priority conservation practices that improve water quality and provide other environmental benefits.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The State of Maryland is obligated to meet the Phase 3 Watershed Implementation Plan (“WIP”) goals approved by EPA by 2025 and much of the necessary reductions are anticipated to come from the agricultural sector. MDA’s ability to provide additional funding assistance will be an important incentive to farmers to install these practices, helping the State reach its WIP goals.

Maryland farmers have committed to do their part to help the State meet the WIP goals approved by EPA. However, some conservation practices result in lost crop production and new maintenance requirements and many Maryland farmers work on slim profit margins. For this reason, additional funding assistance may be needed to advance the adoption of these practices. MDA’s ability to provide additional funding assistance will be an important incentive to farmers to install these practices, helping the State reach its WIP goals.
