**SAMPLE NOTICE FOR PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND STAFF  
OF A SPACE SPRAY APPLICATION**

**NOTIFICATION TO PARENTS, GUARDIANS AND STAFF  
REGARDING THE PLANNED SPACE SPRAYING OF A PESTICIDE**

Integrated pest management procedures such as inspections and monitoring are used to identify conditions contributing to pest problems and to determine when to control pests. One or more pest control methods that would be used as a first response include sanitation, structural repair, other nonchemical methods and , when nontoxic options are unreasonable or have been exhausted, pesticides. It has been determined that a current pest problem warrants the use of a pesticide to be applied as a space spray in order to effectively control the pest problem. This is notice to inform you that a pesticide will be applied as a space spray at the following site as described below.

*“The Office of Pesticide Programs of the United States Environmental Protection Agency has stated: ‘Where possible, persons who potentially are more sensitive, such as pregnant women and infants (less than two years old), should avoid any unnecessary pesticide exposure’ ”.*
